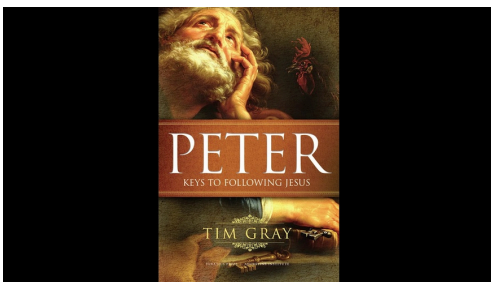
Personal Apostolate
