## MESSAGE FROM BISHOP BURBIDGE

I join the faithful of the Diocese of Arlington in fervent prayer for all the victims, for those who are still missing, and all those whose lives have been affected by the catastrophic flash floods that took place in Central Texas over Independence Day weekend. ## SAINT ANTHONY'S FOOD PANTRY

Your St Anthony Food Pantry has just finished up the 2025 reporting year which runs from 1 July to 30 June.

Here are some stats you may be interested in:

- We have 14 regular volunteers and an additional 5 to 6 during the year to help when available
- We distributed 48,000 lbs from the Fredericksburg Food Bank and 20,000 lbs donated by Food Lion (fruits, vegetables, deli items, bakery, and frozen meats)
- 9000 lbs donated By Catholic Charities
- Two parish food drives
- Purchased fresh food with the aid of your generous donations
- Provided special Thanksgiving and Easter boxes
- We serve around 40 families each week.
- Provided approximately 77,000 lbs of food.

# COEMETERIUM SANCTA TRINITAS BLESSED TRINITY CEMETERY

No one wants to think about it, but death and burial can be a huge burden on a grieving family. Have you thought about what your family will do? Plan today for your family tomorrow.

Our new cemetery has added trees, bushes and a stone walkway. Nearby a Grief Trail twists through the trees. Last year we hosted a Rosary Walk, Luminary event, Traditional Latin Mass for All Souls and a Veterans Day wreath laying.



Every grave is required to have a headstone which will face East, the traditional direction of Christian burial, awaiting the Coming of the Lord on the Day of Resurrection.

This hallowed burial place is bounded by a lovely forest and is laid out in a traditional pattern with walkways, benches and plantings.

Each grave is \$2800 for urn or casket.
