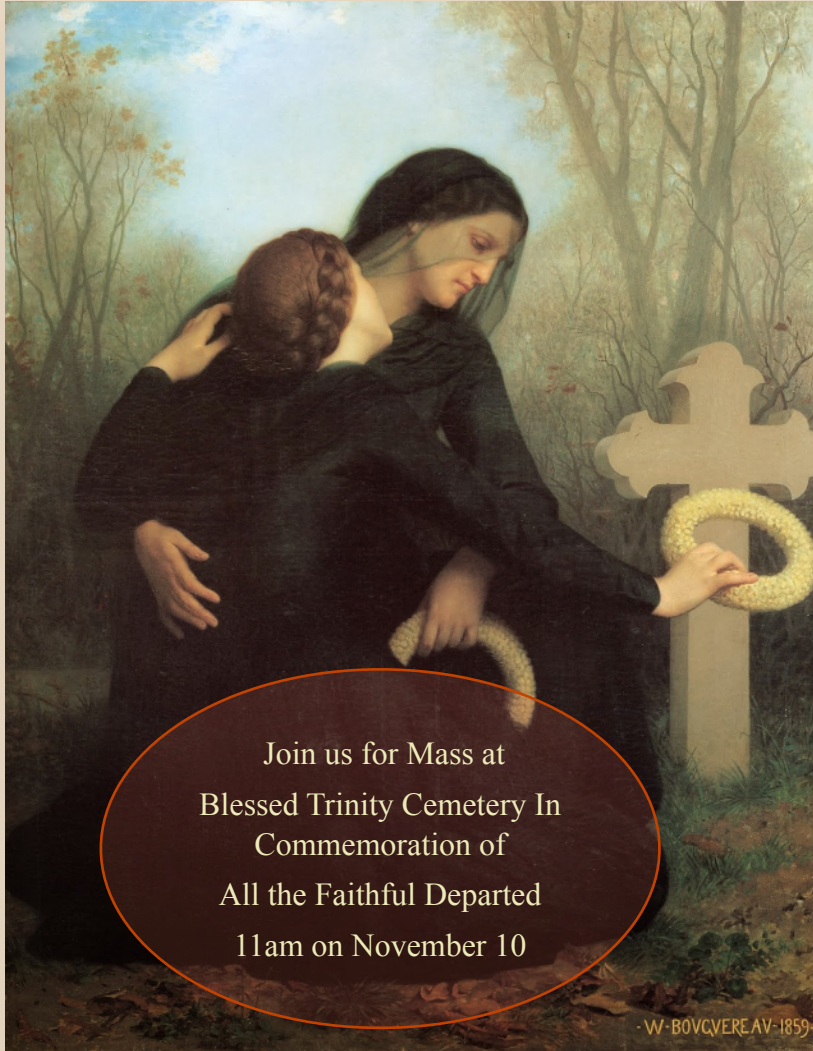

Bishop Burbidge has been exploring the possibility of a Catholic-based Career & Technical Education (CTE)/ Vocational program in the diocese of Arlington. A recent survey of the diocese showed that 92% of parishioners enthusiastically support it.
